



Open Tutor Positions as of July 13, 2025

Heritage will provide curriculum, including teacher books, for all classes listed. Tutors create their own syllabi and may adapt the curriculum lesson plans as needed or preferred. Heritage classes emphasize hands-on learning through projects, games, practice, crafts, discussion, labs, etc.

1st and 2nd Grade Bible:

This tutor will teach the second grade class during 1st semester (September through January), and the first grade class during 2nd semester (January through May), most likely repeating the same curricular material with both grades. The class takes place Monday and Wednesday, from 12:30 pm to 1:30 pm.

3rd and 4th Grade Bible:

This tutor will teach the fourth grade class during 1st semester (September to January), and the third grade class during 2nd semester (January through May), most likely repeating the same curricular material with both grades. The class takes place Monday and Wednesday, from 10:30 to 11:30 am.

Math 5:

This tutor will teach Abeka Mathematics 5 from 8:30 am to 9:30 am on Monday and Wednesday mornings, September through May.

Intermediate Math:

This tutor will teach Abeka Intermediate Math (the equivalent of Math 7) from 8:30 am to 9:30 am on Monday and Wednesday mornings, September through May. Our middle school math tutors also provide Tuesday and Thursday classes online (via Zoom) at a time of their choice.

5th Grade English Language Arts:

This tutor will teach writing, grammar, and literature using IEW (Institutes for Excellence in Writing), Growing With Grammar, and a selection of fiction and nonfiction books. The class meets on Mondays and Wednesdays from 10:30 am to 11:30 am during 1st semester (September to January) and from 9:30 am to 10:30 am during 2nd semester (January through May). This class may be taught alongside 6th Grade ELA, as the curricula are similar, with slight differences for the two grade levels.

6th Grade English Language Arts:

This tutor will teach writing, grammar, and literature using IEW (Institutes for Excellence in Writing), Growing With Grammar, and a selection of fiction and nonfiction books. The class meets on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9:30 am to 10:30 am during 1st semester (September to January) and from 10:30 am to 12:30 am during 2nd semester (January through May). This class may be taught alongside 5th Grade ELA, as the curricula are similar, with slight differences for the two grade levels.

5th Grade History:

This tutor will teach history using *The Story of the World Volume 3: Early Modern Times*. The class meets from 1:30 to 2:30 pm on Mondays and Wednesdays. 5th Grade History may be taught easily alongside 6th Grade History, as the curricula are identical.

6th Grade History:

This tutor will teach history using *The Story of the World Volume 3: Early Modern Times*. The class meets at 12:30 to 1:30 pm on Mondays and Wednesdays. 5th Grade History may be taught easily alongside 5th Grade History, as the curricula are identical.
